Based on three important sections from the assessment instructions, check carefully that your Reflective Report contains all these requirements.

The Purpose of the Assessment

1. Have you identified and described what is meant by critical thinking in an academic context?
2. Have you commented on some of the fundamentals of critical thinking and give evidence of their implementation?
3. Have you demonstrated personal reflection through the process of critical analysis?
4. Have you included advantages of Critical Thinking techniques used?

The Assessment Details

1. Have you explained what aspects of Critical Thinking you have focused on e.g. using Critical Thinking as part of your research process?
2. Have you included your own personal reflections based on using critical thinking?
3. Have you described steps that you took and evaluated them?

The Assignment Requirements

1. Have you added a Cover Page to your Reflective Report?
2. Have you followed the instructions about the structure: introduction, main body and conclusion?
3. Have you used page numbers?
4. Have you checked your word limit? It must be between **900-1100 words** (not including any quotes).
5. Have you used Harvard Referencing for your in-text citations and reference list?
6. Have you included a minimum of **three** academic sources in your references?
7. Do you know how to submit your assignment?
8. What is the assessment deadline?
